
## **BUNBURY CATHOLIC COLLEGE**





### **DEPUTY PRINCIPAL - PASTORAL CARE**

#### **POSITION DETAILS:**

Bunbury Catholic College invites applications from passionate and experienced education leaders for the position of Deputy Principal – Pastoral Care to commence from the beginning of Term 1, 2025.

POSITION: DEPUTY PRINCIPAL – PASTORAL CARE

**TENURE:** The initial term of employment is for 3 years from January 1, 2025 until 31

December 2027. Upon completion of a successful review in the third year, a second term of employment may be offered from January 1, 2028 to December 31 2031. Upon completion of a successful review during the seventh year, a further term of three years may be offered. At the conclusion of the tenth year, the position will be externally advertised, and the person will be able to re-apply

for the position.

- Having completed the requirements for CEWA Accreditation for Leadership is desirable.
- Possess highly developed organisational and interpersonal skills, with a proven ability to develop positive relationships with staff, students and parents.
- Experience in leading a Pastoral Team committed to the wellbeing of students and staff.
- Demonstrate high levels of skill and knowledge of contemporary teaching and learning pedagogy.
- A strong understanding and experience in the implementation of the CEWA Child Safe Framework.
- Experience in the successful implementation of wellbeing programs for secondary students, such as the Berry Street Model of Education, The Resilience Project and Teen Mental Health First Aid.
