Uniform Item:	Required or Optional	Term to be Worn:
New Blazer (Unisex)	The Blazer with the new logo is required for Year 7 to Year 9 students for 2025. The Blazer will be optional for Year 10, 11, and 12 students for 2025.	May be worn all year, however, it will be required to be worn to and from school and into Homeroom every day during Terms 2 and 3 (unless a PE day for Year 7 to 10 students).
	By 2028, all year groups will be required to wear the new Blazers with the new logo.	Students will also wear their blazers when they are representing the College at events or for formal occasions, such as Presentation Evening.
		The Blazer may be kept in the student locker when not worn.
Jumper (Unisex)	Optional for Years 7 to 9 students as they are required to wear a blazer.	May be worn all year.
	The jumper will be required for those students in Years 10 to 12 who have not purchased a Blazer.	
Girls New Dress	A new dress will be available for all students to purchase in 2025. This is an optional uniform item.	May be worn all year.
	College formal white socks must be worn with the dress.	
	Students may elect to wear either a dress, or skirt and shirt, throughout the year.	
	The dress can be worn year long and can be worn with the blazer or the jumper, should students elect to wear the dress as a year-long option. (No Tie)

Girls New Tartan Skirt	Incoming Year 7 students and new students in 2025 can purchase the new tartan skirt.	May be worn all year.
	Students may elect to wear either a dress, or skirt and shirt, throughout the year.	
	The new tartan skirt will be optional for other year groups to purchase (depending on stock availability). Please note that if wearing the tartan skirt in winter, a tartan tie must also be worn (Terms 2 and 3).	
	Students are required to wear the College formal white socks with their skirt.	
	As an option, they may purchase their own black tights which can be worn with the skirt in winter months. (Terms 2 and 3.)	
	By 2028, all year groups will be required to wear the new tartan skirt.	
Girls Formal Shirts	The new logo shirt will be required for Year 7 Students and new students in 2025, unless wearing the dress. By 2028, all year groups will be required to wear the new shirt.	All year.
Girls Formal Shorts	Students have the option of wearing the shorts in Terms 1 and 4.	Terms 1 and 4.
Girls Formal Long Pants	Students have the option of wearing the long pants in Terms 2 and 3.	Terms 2 and 3.
Girls Formal White Socks	Required	All year.
Girls Black Tights	Black Tights will be optional. They may be worn with the skirt during winter.	Terms 2 and 3.
Boy Formal Shirts	The new logo shirt will be required for Year 7 students and new students in 2025.	All year.
	By 2028, all year groups will be required to wear the new shirt.	

Boys Formal Shorts	Required	Terms 1 and 4.
Boys Formal Long Pants	Required	Terms 2 and 3.
Boys Formal Grey Socks	Required	All year.
Ties (Unisex)	Required whilst wearing school formal shirt during winter.	Terms 2 and 3.
School Hat	Required for Year 7 to Year 9 students.	Terms 1 and 4.
PE Uniform House Shirt Sport Shorts Sport Socks White Sport Shirt	The PE House Shirt, Sport Shorts and Sport Socks are required to be worn for PE. The House Shirt must also be worn during College House Events. The White Sport Shirt is required when representing the College at external events. This shirt may also be worn for PE.	Applies to PE classes throughout the year. Students in Year 7 to 10 may wear their PE uniform to and from school on days when they have PE. If no PE classes on that day, students must wear formal uniform. Formal uniform requirements apply for whole-College Assemblies and Mass as well as other formal College events.
School Bag with BCC Logo	Year 7 2025 students will be required to purchase the new School Bag with the new logo. The old logo school bags will still be acceptable until requiring replacement.
